3. Minutes and Matters Arising

3.1 Minute 2.11 – Susan Haskins works - SL advised that there have been developments in this case and that it is ongoing.

3.4 Minute 5.3 – Communication problems and complaints system - SL advised that this is a burning issue and is still on the agenda.

3.5 Minute 5.9 – FFT Completion certificates - SL advised that she is still not happy with the answer and wants to know if FFT have ladders.
EB confirmed that FFT have ladders.

JV confirmed that FFT have a contract to certify the completion of works. JV advised that he is happy to investigate examples of this not being the case.

3.7 Minute 6.1 – Works Team safety harnesses - JV confirmed to CG that there are very clear guidelines regarding working at height. If there are no guard rails on the roof in question, then a harness is required.

3.8 Minute 6.1 – Works Team CRB checks - TI confirmed that legislation on CRB checks has changed and that the Works Team are currently considering it and will provide an update the Forum at the next meeting.

4.1 SL would like information on United house/Partners compliance with the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990

5. Chairs Report

5.1 Item 1 – Boundary walls and gates (HFI Monitoring Team) - EA advised there is an error in the Chairs report 1.111. The intention to keep residents informed on a 6 months basis has to be referred to Housing Management to deal with because PFI walls are referred by Partners to HFI but it may be a resources constraint and she will get back to SL.

IW confirmed that Round 2 rear walls are the responsibility of HFI and that although Eileen will endeavour to look in to this, resources are very limited and we are living in a time of financial constraint.

5.2 Item 3 – Forum meetings being open to the public - EB advised that Partners have always wanted Forum Meetings to be proactive and that their current stance is that meetings should only be open to Partners tenants and leaseholders, as well as Partners and HFI staff.

SL asked Forum Members to vote on whether meetings should be open to the public:

Vote – All in favour of open meetings, however any observers must observe only and not interrupt meetings.

5.3 Item 5 – Grant - Forum agreed that SL should go ahead to do what is necessary to set up a bank account for the forum.

6. Tenancy conditions enforcement update from Housing Management Team

6.1 PN ran through the paper and updated the Forum on the progress of the action plan, since he attended the July 2009 Forum Meeting.

6.2 Forum Members discussed final enforcement of Tenancy Conditions. PN advised that the ultimate sanction is eviction and that a County Court Judge is the only person who can make this decision.

6.3 RM suggested that if anyone in the room has an individual complaint then they should give the details to SL. SL said she would take this forward.

SL also advised that the Forum would like to be kept informed and that they will only accept changes in date if they are notified well in advance.
- 7.3 SL asked SK to find out if tenancy checks are carried out on the suitability of an individual living in a particular property. SK agreed to check this and feedback to the Forum.
- 7.4 MD asked SK if the length of time you can be a resident for has been increased, and if so what to. SK agreed to check this and feedback to the Forum.

11. Any other Business

11.1 CG introduced paper on Tenants services authority (TSA) 'The regulatory framework for social housing in England from April 2010'

11.2 He explained that as a result of the new regulations affecting all social housing both himself & SL attended two courses at Trafford Hall Resident-Led Regulations & An Inspector Calls - Tenant Inspectors

He outlined the idea is that there are to be teams of resident inspectors and a scrutiny team working independently with support from Partners.

SL explained that HFI/Council have since advise that it is hoped that there will be a uniform plan across all Islington's social housing management organisations

SL also informed the forum that the TSA & Audit commission complimented the forum set up as a base to start the new arrangement when they come into effect.

11.3 The Forum agreed on the following 3 proposals in principle:

1. The Forum sets about incorporating the functions of regulation, inspection and auditing of processes and procedures, building on its 'existing structure'
2. For this purpose tenant (including leaseholders) Forum members meet mid cycle and well before the May Forum
3. In the meantime we familiarise ourselves with the 'Framework'. Currently it can be downloaded from 'publications' at www.tenantservicesauthority.org. On behalf of the Forum we are requesting Partners to obtain hardcopies for Forum members

- 11.4 CG asked Partners to source hard copies of the TSA's new regulatory framework. AS
- 11.5 SL encouraged other Forum members to look at other courses because the knowledge gained was invaluable.
- 11.6 Forum Members agreed that they were all interested in becoming Tenant Inspectors and in the meantime will help Martin Church with inspections along with SL.
- 11.7 All agreed that Forum Members should have identification cards. AS / KD
- 11.8 RM proposed that SL is given a mobile telephone to use for Forum purposes. EB

12. Works Team update

- 12.1 TI introduced paper in LV's absence and asked the Forum if they had any questions.
- 12.2 SB advised that she would like LV to contact her. AS / LV
- 12.3 SA would like to know why the Works Team install mixer taps in bathrooms but not in kitchens. LV
